



EYFS is, by definition, the foundation blocks of a child's success in school and yet in maths terms there has been very little CPD for EYFS teachers when compared to colleagues in KS1 and KS2.

This training will directly address this issue and consequently set the children on the right path for their journey through primary education.



The EYFS CPD offer is six full day sessions throughout the year, which will focus on a range of mathematical topics including early number acquisition and mathematical operations. Furthermore, it will deepen understanding around the 4Cs of Count, Change, Cardinality and Composition.

Facilitated by a Maths SLE, with additional input from expert EYFS practitioners and Nottingham Trent University, participants will learn about the very latest in Mathematical theory and how it can be applied.

Gap tasks between each session will help embed this theory in the classroom. These gap tasks will form the basis of small research projects that teachers will carry out within their own classroom.
