Service Level Agreement

- Any Transform School can make a booking for the 'Big Camp' equipment by emailing lindsay.clark@transformtrust.co.uk
- Bookings will be allocated on a first come first served basis
- Each booking will be charged a nominal fee of £50 to pay for wear and tear of equipment
- Once your booking has been confirmed a booking form will be emailed to you and must be returned to lindsay.clark@transformtrust.co.uk at least 2 weeks before your collection date
- Equipment can be collected from and returned to Trust Central Unit 11
- Before the camp is dismantled please ensure all tents are dry, if they are not please hang the tents somewhere to dry before packing them away
- **Any damage to equipment should be tagged and reported by email on the return**
- Any significant damage will have to be paid for eg a ripped tent, washing of sleeping bag
- All camps should provide an Impact Statement to Transform Trust by capturing pupil voice and photos (please check photo permission) within 2 weeks of the camp.
